He was the project architect for the conversion of historic buildings forming the Midland Goods Shed and Handyside Canopies in King's Cross, and led the brief-setting exercise and the design development of the Guardian's new civic space. Ed is now leading the design of a new sports hall on site Q2 in King's Cross.
